**Constitutional Mandate**

The Public Protector as an independent institution established by Section 181 to 182 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 gives the Public Protector the power to support and strengthen constitutional democracy by investigating any conduct in state affairs, or in the public administration in any sphere of government, that is alleged or suspected to be improper or to result in any impropriety or prejudice; to report on that conduct; and to take appropriate remedial action. The Public Protector must be accessible to all persons and communities.
